INFORMATION ABOUT UC MARINE INSURANCE

GENERAL: Departments are required to maintain current schedules of all owned vessels, whether operating, non-operating, in use, or in storage. Risk Management should be notified of acquisitions as soon as possible.

LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR POWERED VESSELS <30' & ALL NON-POWERED BOATS: Liability coverage for all powered vessels less than thirty feet (<30') in length and all non-powered vessels is provided under the University's General Liability Self-Insurance Program (UC Business & Finance Bulletin, BUS-75). The General Liability Self-Insurance Program provides coverage for damage or injury caused to third party property, vessels, or persons. Departments will not be assessed a premium for liability insurance coverage for boats in this category.

LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR POWERED VESSELS ≥30': Liability coverage for all UCSB vessels thirty feet (≥30') or more in length is provided under the University's Marine policy. Departments will be assessed a premium for liability insurance coverage under the Marine policy for all boats in this category.

HULL INSURANCE: Hull insurance is highly recommended but not required. It covers physical damage to University vessels, trailers, engines, and oars, including theft. If a department chooses not to insure its vessels or equipment for hull coverage, no coverage will be provided in the event of theft, damage, or loss. For coverage to apply, the vessel or equipment must be reported on this form. Coverage will not be in effect until this form is received by UCSB Risk Management and forwarded to UCSB's insurance broker. If equipment (oars, engines) are to be covered, the value of the equipment must be included in the value of the vessel or scheduled separately.

The deductible is \$250 per occurrence for vessels (some vessels have a higher deductible), \$100 per occurrence for trailers, and \$250 per occurrence for oars.
